Course Prerequisites: Rope Rescue Operations

PPE Requirements: Each day you will be required to bring long pants, sturdy boots, leather gloves, helmet with chin strap, harness (within 10 yrs of manufacture), and water bottle. Be prepared for in-climate weather as instruction may be outside.
