



The Northeastern Illinois Public Safety Training Academy is an intergovernmental agency that serves as a one-of-a-kind cooperative approach to emergency preparedness and response. A unique year-round curriculum is delivered to promote cross-training and communication among first responders at the local, state, and national levels.

The NIPSTA blueprint for success is contained in the Campus Master Plan, which is a 250-page



document that provides a strategic framework for the Academy. Development of the Master Plan was an elaborate process that involved assessing current resources, benchmarking other similar training facilities, planning the NIPSTA site, and estimating probable costs for completion.



Implementation of the multi-million dollar, multi-year Master Plan is well underway.

A comprehensive educational curriculum is now available on-site. This training is complemented by specialized indoor and outdoor props on a spacious 20-acre Campus. Funding from the public and private sectors supports the expansion of NIPSTA programs and facilities.
